Kids, parents, and staff all made the bazaar a success. We had plenty of baked goods, lamps, plants, and Christmas gifts



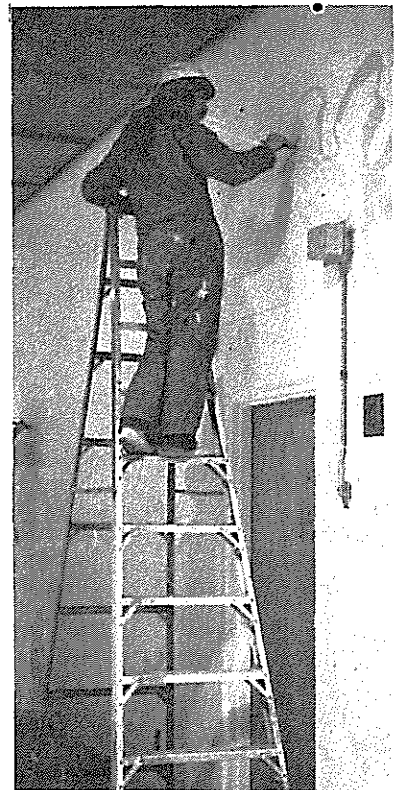
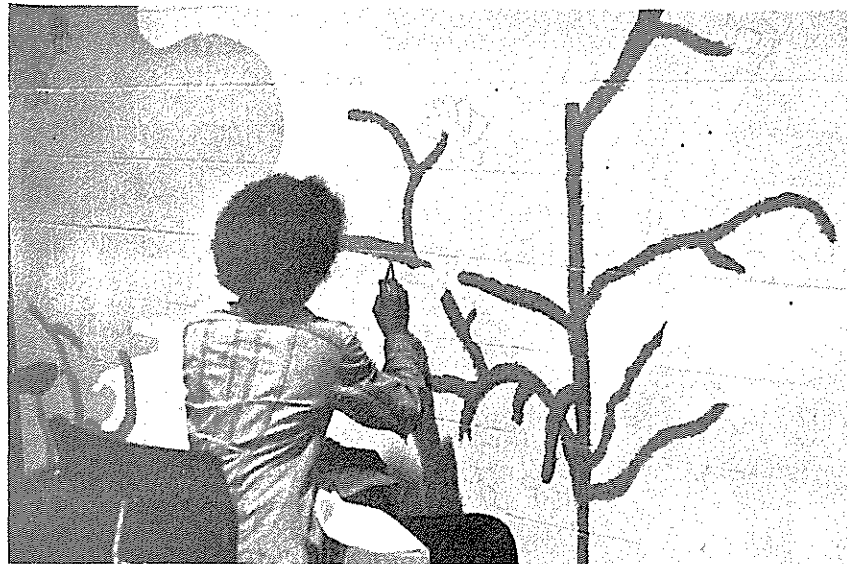
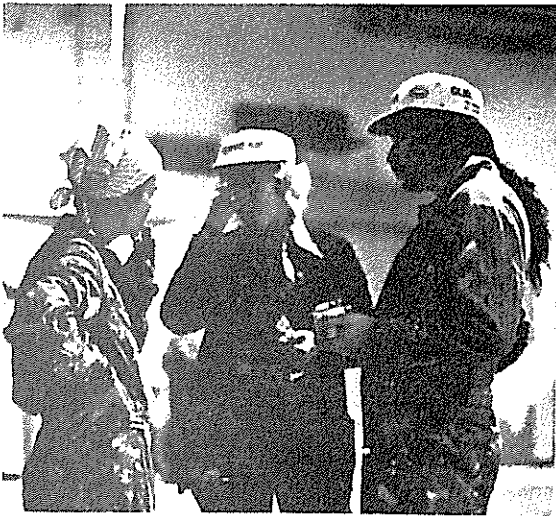
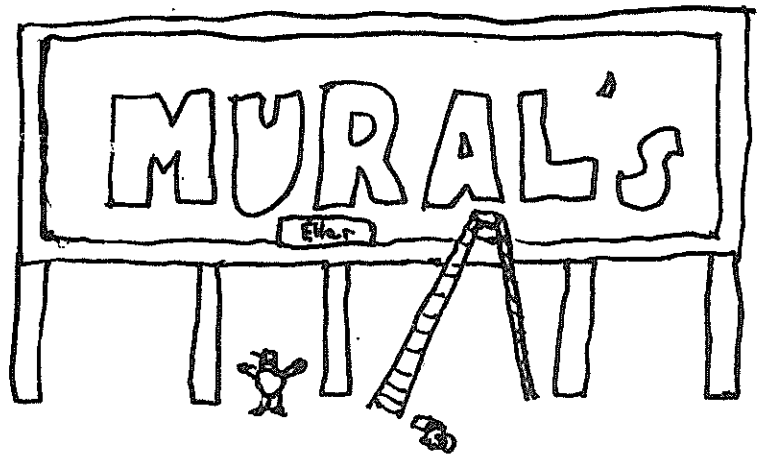
