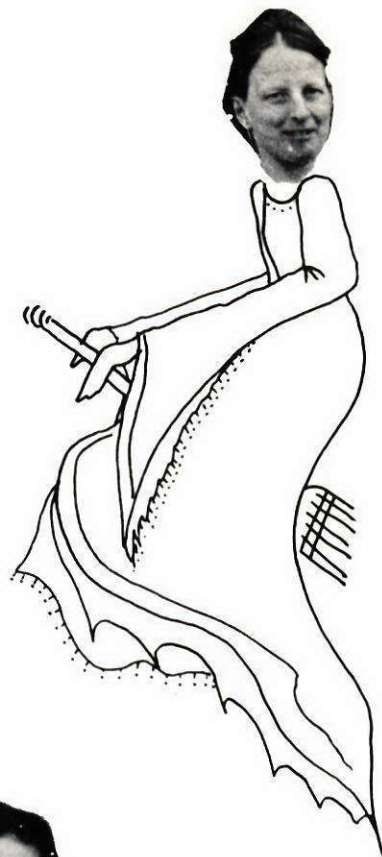

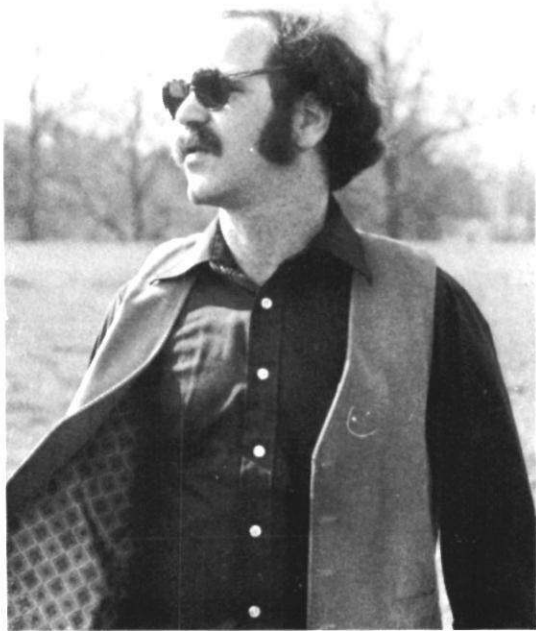

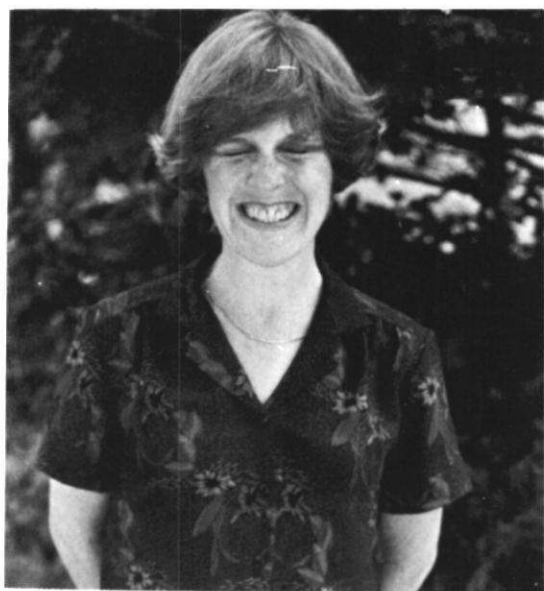


Peter's chess tournament announcements every morning were

Crossroads Annual Olympics were held on a bright, sunny day.

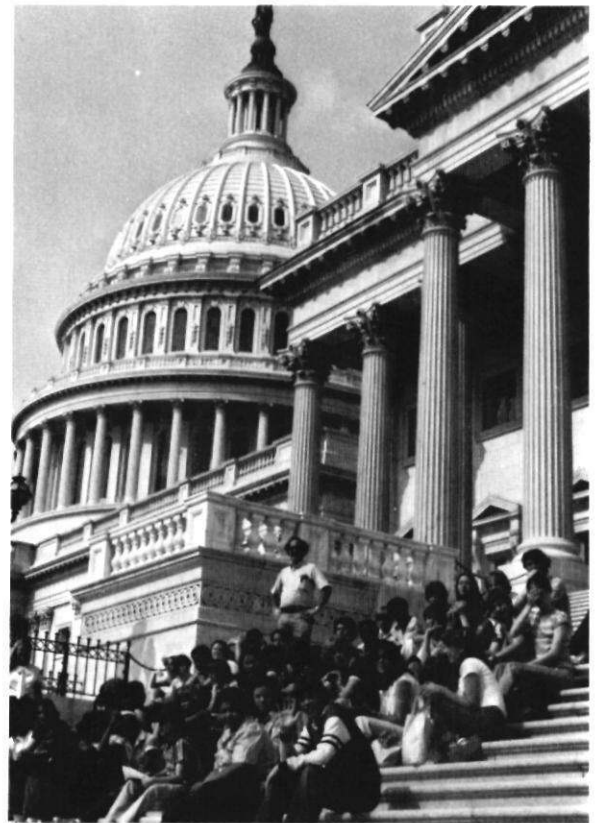
The few stop watches around were put to good use, determining the winners and losses of events including the obstacle course, team marathon run, 100 yard dash, the 50, and many others.
