The Vanderbilt YMCA Youth Hotel was a ten-story building located in midtown Manhattan (on 47th Street). The twenty-six students and the six staff members used this building usually only to sleep (and occasionally to have breakfast). From there we explored all the interesting and exciting places in Manhattan. Ten Days were easily filled with visits to the vast number of Art Museums (from the Modern Museum of Art over the Guggenheim to the Cloisters; and many others), a visit to the U.N. Headquarters, the magnificent New York Public Library, a bus tour through other neighbourhoods, like Harlem or the Bronx, and walking tours of Greenwich Village and Washington Square. Carol also gave the students a lot of time to go back to the places that they had seen and liked, or to discover new places. Often Carol would set up a meeting place and time for the afternoon and leave the morning as free time. For this reason Carol had wisely planned ahead, and scheduled a day on Fire Island. For one day we played on the beach, and had a very different perspective. One unbelievable fact needs to be mentioned: Not once a student was late, and not once a major accident occurred.

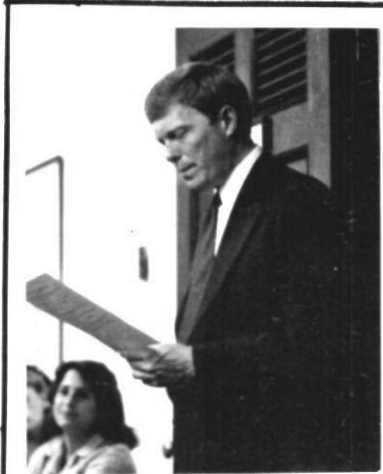

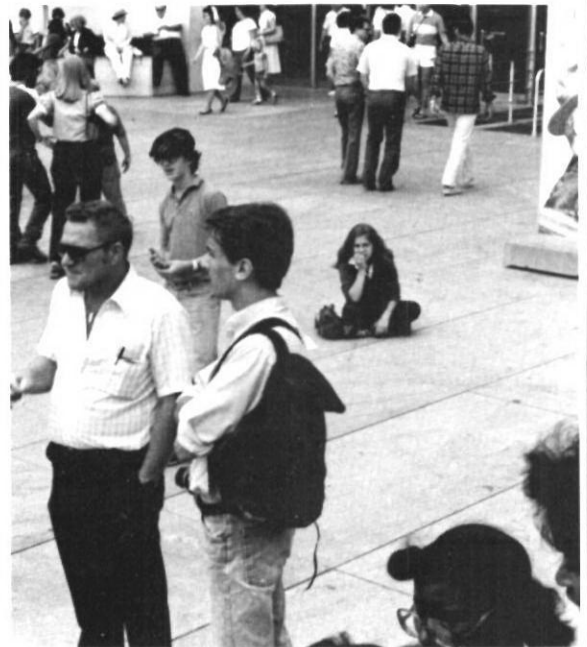

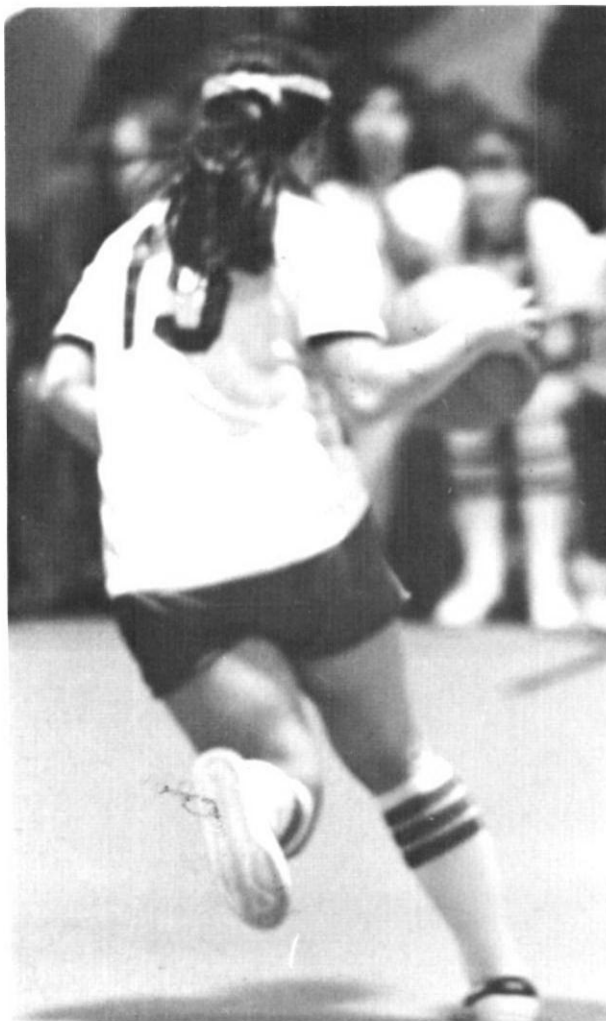
## SPORTS AT CROSSROADS

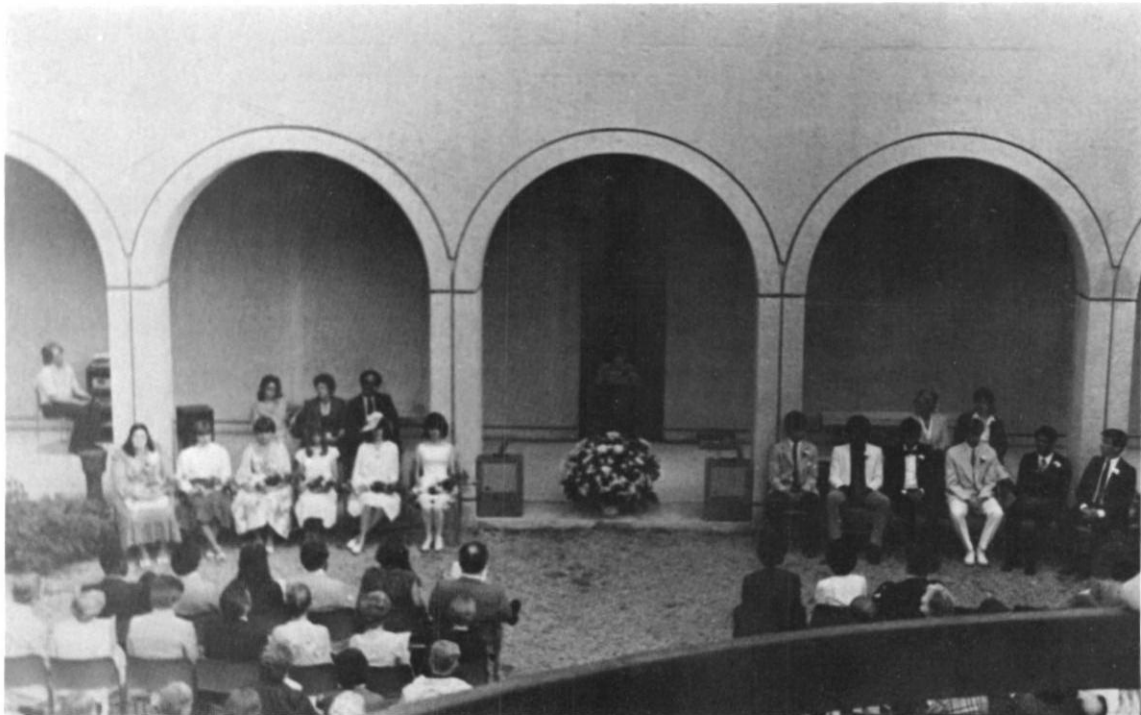

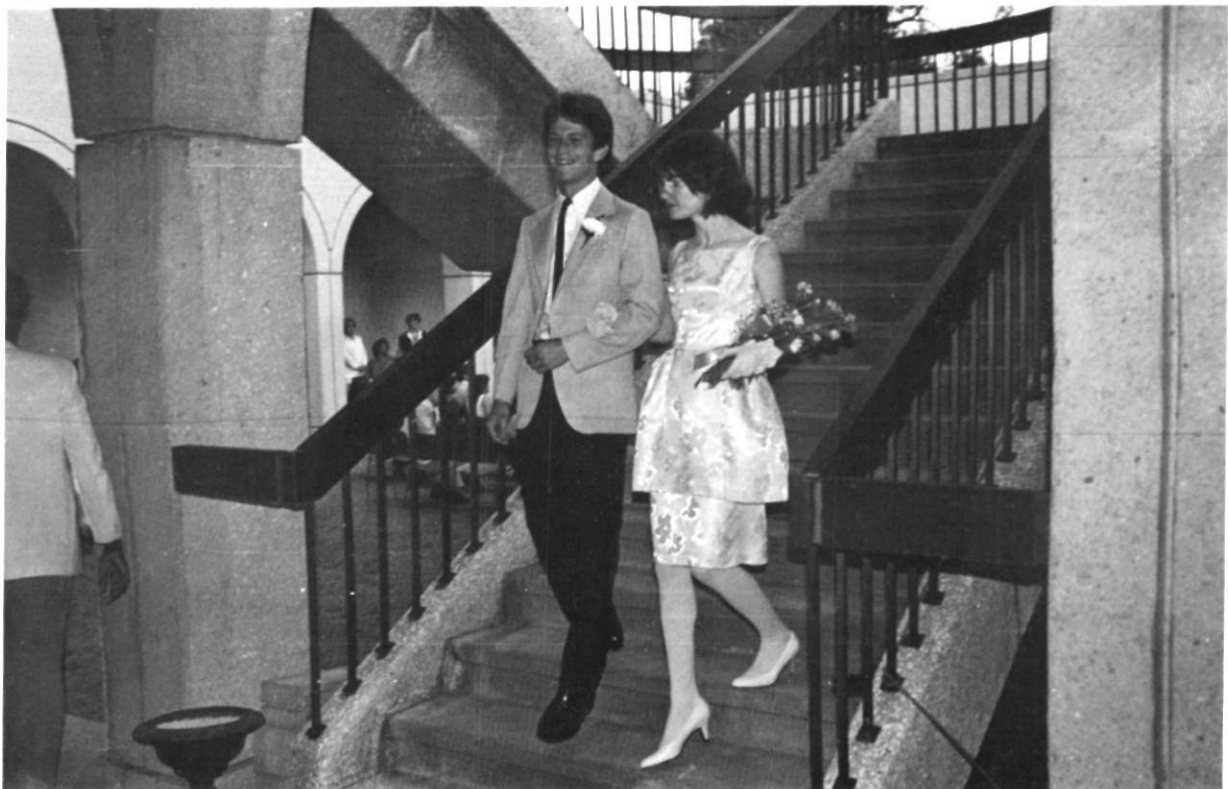
