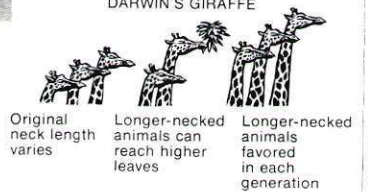


Figure 1.6 Opposing explanations of how the giraffe got a long neck.
